Possible job titles for a special education major in the emotional disturbances/learning disabilities track include teacher for learning disabled/emotionally disabled/handicapped, resource room teacher; the mental retardation track includes special education teacher, teacher for students with mental handicaps; the visual disabilities track includes resource room teacher for visually impaired, orientation and mobility specialist, itinerant teacher of the visually impaired, home teacher of the adult blind, teacher of the visually impaired, special education director.

Entrance Requirements

All Special Ed. programs are limited access, limited enrollment. The ED/LD track is a combined Bachelor's & Master's Degree. These programs are in the College of Education and require a minimum 2.5 GPA and passing scores on all parts of the CLAST or on the general knowledge section of the FTCE for admission. Previous experience with individuals with disabilities (for example, volunteer work) is strongly suggested. Admissions deadline: Prospective students should complete the [departmental application](#) early in the sophomore year – or after completion of approximately 30 semester hours of course work and complete an interview with an FSU faculty member in Special Education to determine interest and commitment to the program.

FSU WILL DENY ADMISSION TO ANY STUDENT WHO HAS NOT SATISFIED THE STATE FOREIGN LANGUAGE ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENT.

FSU requires basic [computer proficiency](#). EME 2040 will satisfy this requirement

Applicants must be fingerprinted and pass a security clearance prior to admission into the program.
