Entrance Requirements

This is a limited access program. Fall only admissions. March 1 application deadline. Minimum 2.5 GPA required; preference given to 2.75 and higher. The program [application](#) is available online.

FSU requires basic [computer proficiency](#). CGS 1060, CGS 1100, or EME 2040 will satisfy this requirement.

FSU requires competency in oral communications for graduation. If students took a speech course in high school or were members of a debate team, they may exempt this requirement during the FSU admissions process. If not, students should take SPC 2600 at Chipola to satisfy this requirement.
