Entrance Requirements

This is a limited access program. All entering music majors are required to take a placement audition (heard by a faculty jury) in applied music. Students are expected to be prepared to play or sing representative works. A minimum GPA of 2.5 is required. Applicants must pass all four parts of the CLAST exam. If the CLAST requirement is satisfied with an alternative method, then applicants must present passing scores on the general knowledge section of the FTCE for admission to the College of Education. A minimum music GPA of 3.0 is also required.

FSU WILL DENY ADMISSION TO ANY STUDENT WHO HAS NOT SATISFIED THE STATE FOREIGN LANGUAGE ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENT.

FSU requires basic [computer proficiency](#). EME 2040 will satisfy this requirement.

Applicants must be fingerprinted and pass a security clearance for admission to the major.
