Entrance Requirements

October 1 is the application deadline for admission the following fall term. This is needed to schedule a spring audition. All materials must be completed by January 1. A GPA of 3.0 is required for admission.

Theatre is a synthesis of many arts. At FSU a student may choose to study theatre as a part of a broad liberal arts education through the B.A. program or choose to intensively study a particular area through one of the B.F.A. degree programs. Check FSU website for GPA and audition requirements and audition dates. Areas of emphasis for the B.F.A. degree are: Acting, Design/Technology, and **Music Theatre**.

FSU WILL DENY ADMISSION TO ANY STUDENT WHO HAS NOT SATISFIED THE STATE FOREIGN LANGUAGE ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENT. The BA degree requires an additional 4 hours of foreign language at the 2220 level for graduation from FSU; the BFA does not have this requirement.

FSU requires basic [computer proficiency](#). CGS 1060 will satisfy this requirement.
