Entrance Requirements

A minimum GPA of 2.5 is required. Applicants must pass all four parts of the CLAST exam. If the CLAST requirement is satisfied with an alternative method, then applicants must present passing scores on the general knowledge section of the FTCE for admission to the College of Education. A minimum GPA of 3.0 in art/art history classes is required for admission into Art Education. Other tracks include pre-art therapy and community service art.

FSU WILL DENY ADMISSION TO ANY STUDENT WHO HAS NOT SATISFIED THE STATE FOREIGN LANGUAGE ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENT.

FSU requires basic [computer proficiency](#). EME 2040 will satisfy this requirement.

Applicants must be fingerprinted and pass a security clearance prior to admission into the program.
