

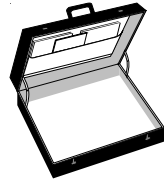
This Associate in Arts degree program is designed for those students who expect to transfer and earn a degree in the College of Business at the University of Florida.

Entrance Requirements

All prerequisites must be completed to be included in the applicant pool. A minimum overall GPA and a minimum on all attempts of preprofessional courses are required for admission to the College of Business. GPA requirements vary by major; most are 3.7 or higher. Check the [UF website](#) for specifics. All prerequisites must be completed before enrolling at UF. **The College of Business will recompute your GPA based on all attempts on all critical tracking courses. Once a grade of "C" or higher is earned, no subsequent grade in that course will be calculated into the preprofessional GPA.**

UF will deny admission to any student who has not satisfied the state foreign language admissions requirement.

It is required for all other majors in the College of Business. ACG 2021 and MAC 2233 must be completed at time of application.
