

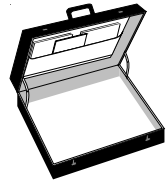
This Bachelor of Applied Science degree program is designed for students who plan to earn a BAS degree in business management at Chipola College.

Admission Requirements to the BAS program:

1. Applicants must have earned an Associate in Science (AS) or Associate in Arts (AA) degree; AS graduates must complete additional general education credits before earning the BAS in Business Management. Applicants with an AA earned in state other than Florida must complete the Chipola general education requirements as outlined in Florida Statutes 1007.25 (8).
2. Applicants must complete supplemental BAS application.
3. Applicants must provide an official transcript from all previous institutions attended.
4. Applicants must have an overall minimum GPA of 2.0

If two years of high school credit in the same foreign language have been completed, the graduation requirement for a baccalaureate degree in Florida is satisfied. If not, two semesters of the same foreign language must be completed at Chipola before earning the baccalaureate degree.
