

This Associate in Arts degree program has been designed for students who plan to transfer to the College of Allied Health and earn a degree in Respiratory Therapy at Florida A & M University.

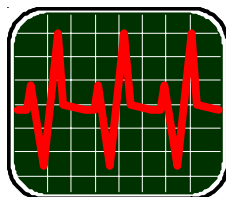
