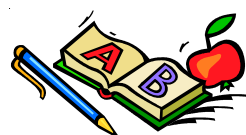

Entrance Requirements

This is a limited access program.

A minimum GPA of 2.5 is required. Applicants must pass all four parts of the CLAST exam. If the CLAST requirement is satisfied with an alternative method, then applicants must present passing scores on the general knowledge section of the FTCE for admission to the program.

Applicants must complete a self-disclosure form that requires them to respond to any personal criminal background information; they must also be fingerprinted.

If two years of high school credit in the same foreign language have been completed, the graduation requirement for a baccalaureate degree in Florida is satisfied. If not, two semesters of the same foreign language must be completed at Chipola before earning the baccalaureate degree.
