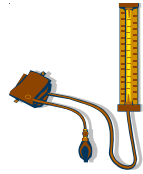

Entrance Requirements

This is a limited access, limited enrollment program. Check the College website for admissions deadlines, etc. Students must have a minimum overall GPA of 2.5 in all college credit course work and a minimum grade of "C" in all Florida Common Course Prerequisites applicable to the AS to BSN degree program; however, if space is available, students with a GPA of less than 2.5 may be admitted on a provisional basis. If two years of high school credit in the same foreign language have been completed, the graduation requirement for a baccalaureate degree in Florida is satisfied. If not, two semesters of the same foreign language must be completed at Chipola before earning the baccalaureate degree.

Admission into this program requires official transcripts showing an A.S. Degree in Nursing from a regionally accredited institution; a valid, unrestricted, unencumbered RN license from the state of Florida, Alabama, or Georgia (to be kept current throughout the duration of the required course of study); an AA degree from a Florida public institution OR 60 semester hours and satisfactory completion of Chipola's general education requirements (all courses that meet Gordon rule general education requirements must be completed with a minimum grade of "C"); completion of all prerequisite courses with a minimum grade of "C"; and a completed supplemental BSN application.
