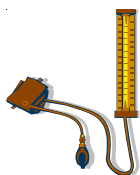

#### Entrance Requirements

This is a limited access program. The departmental application deadlines are much earlier than the university application deadlines for the Panama City campus. Students are encouraged to submit both applications by the departmental deadline dates: Fall (June 1), Spring (Oct. 1), and Summer (Mar. 1).

Students must have a minimum overall GPA of 2.7 and a minimum science GPA of 2.5 (See note 3 below). Students must be able to speak, read, and write English proficiently.

FSU WILL DENY ADMISSION TO ANY STUDENT WHO HAS NOT SATISFIED THE STATE FOREIGN LANGUAGE ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENT.

FSU requires basic [computer proficiency](#) for graduation. NUR 3167 Research Process for Professional Nursing (required course) will satisfy this requirement.

Students must pass a criminal background check.

**Attention:** ADN to BSN students: FSU has upper division courses that will meet the speech requirement (NUR 4642) and the multicultural requirement (NUR 3655). Consider taking these two courses as a part of your 30 hours of upper division work for the BSN.
