⁴ CGS 1060 will satisfy FSU's basic computer proficiency for graduation.

⁵ FSU requires competency in oral communications for graduation. If students took a speech course in high school or were members of a debate team, they may exempt this requirement during the FSU admissions process. If not, students should take SPC 2600 at Chipola to satisfy this requirement. FSU does have a required social work course (SOW 3350) that satisfies the oral competency graduation requirement.
