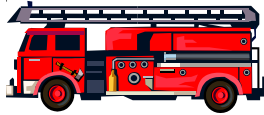

This program is design to meet the requirements of the statewide articulation agreement for AS to BS in Fire & Emergency Services.

Students that have completed the State of Florida Basic Recruit Training Program and have passed the state certification exam may receive up to 10 elective credits toward this program. The courses are treated like transfer credit. Students will not have the Workforce Development credit posted to their permanent record until they have completed 12 college credit semester hours, have earned a 2.0 GPA, and are currently enrolled at Chipola College. For degree completion, at least 25 percent of the college semester hours must be earned through instruction in the academic instruction of Chipola College. Interested applicants must initiate this process through Admissions and Records. Fees apply for the transfer process.
