- Complete an Associate in Arts Degree or at least 60 semester credit hours of postsecondary education with completion of the Chipola College general education requirement from a regionally accredited institution.
- Complete the following prerequisites, ECO 2013, ECO 2023, MAC 2233, STA 2023 or STA 2122 or QMB 2100, CGS 1100, ACG 2021, ACG 2071
 - Students seeing admission to the Accounting Track must complete ACG 2021 and ACG 2071 with a grade of "B" or higher.
- Cumulative grade point average of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale in all postsecondary coursework.
- Completed the state-mandated business common prerequisites as listed on the program curriculum guide.
- \Box All upper level course work requires a grade of "C" or higher.

ADMISSION PROCEDURES

- <u>New students</u> must submit a Chipola College general application for admission. <u>Former Chipola students</u>, who have not attended Chipola in the past year, must submit an updated Chipola College general application for admission.
- 2. All applicants must complete the Baccalaureate Supplemental Application.
- 3. All applicants must request official transcripts from high school or a GED.
- 4. All applicants must request official transcripts from <u>all previous institutions</u> (not including Chipola College).
