Certified Nursing Assistant

Chipola College will offer a Certified Nursing Assistant Course.

This program is designed to prepare Certified Nursing Assistant students for employment as nursing assistants, or to provide supplemental training for persons previously or currently employed in these occupations.

This program offers a broad foundation of knowledge and skills of the traditional role of the nursing assistant. Upon completion, the graduate will be prepared to care for patients in the hospital or nursing home.

The Nursing Assistant Course is 120 hours in length, meeting the criteria and objectives of the State of Florida Approved Curriculum.

This course totaling 120 hours consists of:

Certified Nursing Assistant 120 Course Hours

The class will be offered beginning **Spring 2021**. Classroom instruction will be offered on the Chipola College campus, while clinical experiences will be held in Marianna, Florida. Students are responsible for their own transportation to and from the clinical site. Daily attendance is necessary and an attendance policy is in place. Information about books, supplies, and uniforms is attached. Contact the Health Sciences department at **850-718-2316** if additional information is needed.

The class will be limited to **15 students**. Upon successful completion of the course, the students will be eligible to take the NACE (Nursing Assistant Certification Exam), written and clinical, for a fee of \$155.00. Financial Aid may be available through Career Source, Tri-County Community Council, and the Chipola Foundation.

Steps to Enrolling

1. Complete the Application for Admission to the college and submit to Student Services by **December 4, 2020**.
2. Complete the Nursing Assistant Application and submit to Health Sciences by **January 15, 2021**.
3. *Chipola accepts applications through the last day of registration as listed in the college calendar; however, applications that are submitted earlier improve registration opportunities in desired classes.*
4. If accepted into the program, new students will receive notice of acceptance via email notification.
5. Attend classes in the Health Science Building.
