New students will receive, by email, an acceptance letter, registration instructions and general college information.

Continuing students who have maintained enrollment at Chipola do not have to complete another application. However, they must complete and submit a new Course Approval Form each term they enroll, and if applicable, new test scores, and transcripts. Advising and registration appointments will not be automatically scheduled. Students need to check the college calendar for registration dates.
