All first time in college (Fall 2014 and beyond) students are required to successfully complete two years of the same foreign language in high school or two semesters of the same foreign language at the college level before the associate degree is awarded. This major is in the College of Arts and Sciences and requires completion of a foreign language through the 2220 level.

FSU requires an Oral Competency Course: SPC 2608 meets this requirement.

FSU requires a Digital Literacy Competency Course: CGS 1060 meets this requirement.
