² If you do not plan to pursue public school teacher preparation, then you may choose elective courses. FSU requires basic computer proficiency. CGS 1060, CGS 1100, or EME 2040 will satisfy this requirement. Grade of "C" or higher required.

³ FSU requires 6 hrs. of international/diversity courses in addition to EDF 2085. If you complete an AA degree before transferring, FSU only requires 3 hrs. of international/diversity coursework. Chipola courses that meet this requirement include: AMH 2091/2093, ASH 1044, GEA 2001/2002, REL 2300, SYG 1010, and THE 1000.

⁴ If student has taken 2 credits of Foreign Language in high school then choose elective. Students must demonstrate proficiency at the intermediate (2200) level in a modern or classical language at the advanced level in sign language (ASL 2160C) at FSU.
