FSU requires 6 hrs. of international/diversity courses. If you complete an AA degree before transferring, FSU only requires 3 hrs. of international/diversity coursework. Chipola courses that meet this requirement include **AMH 2091/2093, ARH 1000, ASH 1044, REL 2300, and THE 1000.**

All first-time-in college (Fall 2014 and beyond) students are required to successfully complete two years of the same foreign language in high school or two semesters of the same foreign language at the college level before the associate degree is awarded.

FSU requires an Oral Competency Course: SPC 2608 meets this requirement.

FSU requires a Digital Literacy Competency Course: CGS 1060 meets this requirement.
