<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> FSU requires 6 hrs. of international/diversity courses. If you complete an AA degree before transferring, FSU only requires 3 hrs. of international/diversity coursework. Chipola courses that meet this requirement include AMH 2091/2093, ASH 1044, GEA 2001/2002, REL 2300, SYG 1010, and THE 1000.

<sup>3</sup> Students must complete 9 hours of coursework ("C" or higher) with any combination of the following prefixes: ACG, CGS, ECO, GEB, MAR, ORI, PET, SPC, and/or STA.
