4 FSU requires 6 hrs. of international/diversity courses. If you complete an AA degree before transferring, FSU only requires 3 hrs. of international/diversity coursework.
5 This major requires completion of a foreign language through the 2220 level before graduation from FSU.
6 Prerequisite coursework. Must be completed with a "C" or higher.
