Testing: As per FL. Rule 6A-10.040, students enrolled in a postsecondary program offered for career education credit of 450 hours or more shall complete the entry-level basic skills examination (TABE) within the first six weeks after admission into the program.

Entrance Requirements:

1. Age: 18
2. Passing TABE-Level A Scores (all programs 450 or more hours)
3. A standard high school diploma or GED is required for employment in Florida.
4. Law: No prior felony convictions; no misdemeanors related to firefighting.
5. FDLE: Fingerprint clearance is completed before certification.
6. For employment, candidates must pass the state certification standards exam.
7. Day classes 8 hour days for 4 days a week (approximately 14 weeks)
8. Night classes available
