Entrance Requirements

This is a limited access major; admission is competitive. Visit the FSU department website or contact the department directly for more information. **Students entering the undergraduate program as of Fall 2016 will be required to complete a graduate professional athletic training program in order to become Board of Certification eligible.** Since access to clinical opportunities is limited, students must complete the following to be admitted: 1) a minimum FSU GPA of 2.5 or higher on a minimum of 12 hours, 2) successful completion of ATR1800, and 3) must meet all technical standards for admission. Contact an FSU advisor for details. ***Formal acceptance into the major occurs ONLY in the Spring semester.***

The athletic training education program is accredited by the Commission on Accreditation of Athletic Training Education (CAATE) Programs and prepares students to take the Board of Certification (BOC) examination. All Athletic Training core courses must be taken at FSU.

All first time in college (Fall 2014 and beyond) students are required to successfully complete two years of the same foreign language in high school or two semesters of the same foreign language at the college level before the associate degree is awarded. Home School students must demonstrate competency through competency testing.

FSU requires competency in oral communications for graduation. If students took a speech course in high school or were members of a debate team, they may exempt this requirement during the FSU admissions process. If not, students should take **SPC 2608** at Chipola to satisfy this requirement.

⁵ FSU requires 6 hrs. of international/diversity courses. If you complete an AA degree before transferring, FSU only requires 3 hrs. of international/diversity coursework. Chipola courses that meet this requirement include AMH 2091/2093, ASH 1044, GEA 2001/2002, REL 2300, SYG 1010, and THE 1000.

⁶ **FSU requires basic computer proficiency. CGS 1060 will satisfy this requirement; grade of "C" or higher is required.**

⁷ **All first-time-in-college students (Fall 2018 and beyond) are required to demonstrate competency in civic literacy through one of the following options:**

1) successfully passing either POS 2041 American Federal Government or AMH 2020 American History Since 1865, or 2) achieving the standard score on AP Government and Politics: United States, AP United States History or CLEP: American Government.
