Entrance Requirements

All prerequisites must be completed to be included in the applicant pool. A minimum overall GPA and a minimum on all attempts of preprofessional courses are required for admission to the College of Business. GPA requirements vary by major; most are 3.0 or higher. Check the [UF website](#) for specifics. All prerequisites must be completed before enrolling at UF. **The College of Business will recompute your GPA based on all attempts on all critical tracking courses. Once a grade of "C" or higher is earned, no subsequent grade in that course will be calculated into the preprofessional GPA.**

All first time in college (Fall 2014 and beyond) students are required to successfully complete two years of the same foreign language in high school or two semesters of the same foreign language at the college level before the associate degree is awarded. Home School students must demonstrate competency through competency testing.
