Entrance Requirements

A minimum GPA of 3.0 is required to have your application reviewed for admission into this program. Admission is for the summer or fall semester only. Please visit the department website, <http://commdisorders.ccfsu.edu/> regarding the application process and deadlines.

All first time in college (Fall 2014 and beyond) students are required to successfully complete two years of the same foreign language in high school or two semesters of the same foreign language at the college level before the associate degree is awarded. Home School students must demonstrate competency through competency testing. Students must achieve proficiency in a language other than English prior to graduation. The requirement may be fulfilled either by demonstrating proficiency at the intermediate (2200) level in a modern or classical language or at the advanced level in sign language (ASL 2160C) at FSU.

A master's degree is required for certification and licensure in either audiology or speech pathology; students should plan to continue in a graduate program. FSU requires one Natural Science course with a Lab to be completed before graduation. This is not an admission requirement.

² If you do not plan to pursue public school teacher preparation, then you may choose elective courses. FSU requires basic computer proficiency. CGS 1060, CGS 1100, or EME 2040 will satisfy this requirement. Grade of "C" or higher required.

³ If you have completed STA 2122, you have met this requirement. You cannot receive credit for both STA 2122 and STA 2023.

⁴ FSU requires 6 hrs. of international/diversity courses in addition to EDF 2085. If you complete an AA degree before transferring, FSU only requires 3 hrs. of international/diversity coursework. Chipola courses that meet this requirement include: AMH 2091/2093, ASH 1044, GEA 2001/2002, REL 2300, SYG 1010, and THE 1000.

⁵ If student has taken 2 credits of Foreign Language in high school then choose elective. Students must demonstrate proficiency at the intermediate (2200) level in a modern or classical language at the advanced level in sign language (ASL 2160C) at FSU.

⁶ **All first-time-in-college students (Fall 2018 and beyond) are required to demonstrate competency in civic literacy through one of the following options:** 1) successfully passing either POS 2041 American Federal Government or AMH 2020 American History Since 1865, or 2) achieving the standard score on AP Government and Politics: United States, AP United States History or CLEP: American Government.
