### Entrance Requirements

A minimum GPA of 2.0 is required for admission. All first time in college (Fall 2014 and beyond) students are required to successfully complete two years of the same foreign language in high school or two semesters of the same foreign language at the college level before the associate degree is awarded. Home School students must demonstrate competency through competency testing. **This major is in the College of Arts and Sciences and requires completion of a foreign language through the 2220 level before graduation from FSU.** If the additional foreign language is not taken before transfer, student will be required to take a placement test over the material covered in the first two years before being allowed to take additional foreign language. If the student does not pass, he/she may be denied admission into the program.

<sup>3</sup> Must choose one course from the following: MAC 1105, MAC 1311, MGF 1106, MGF 1107, STA 2023.

<sup>4</sup> If student has taken 2 credits of Foreign Language in high school then choose elective. **This major is in the College of Arts and Sciences and requires completion of a foreign language through the 2220 level before graduation from FSU.**

<sup>5</sup> Choose one of the following: ARH 1000, HUM 1020, MUL 2010, THE 1000.

<sup>6</sup> FSU requires one Natural Science course with a Lab to be completed before graduation. Must earn a grade of "C" or higher. This is not an admission requirement.

<sup>7</sup> FSU requires 6 hrs. of international/diversity courses. If you complete an AA degree before transferring, FSU only requires 3 hrs. of international/diversity coursework. Chipola courses that meet this requirement include AMH 2091/2093, ASH 1044, GEA 2001/2002, REL 2300, SYG 1010, and THE 1000.

<sup>8</sup> FSU requires basic computer proficiency. **CGS 1060** or EME 2040 will satisfy this requirement; must earn a grade of "C" or higher.

<sup>9</sup> FSU requires a basic Oral Competency, must earn a grade of "C" or higher.

<sup>10</sup> **All first-time-in-college students (Fall 2018 and beyond) are required to demonstrate competency in civic literacy through one of the following options:** 1) successfully passing either POS 2041 American Federal Government or AMH 2020 American History Since 1865, or 2) achieving the standard score on AP Government and Politics: United States, AP United States History or CLEP: American Government.
