Entrance Requirements

Completion of an A.A. degree from a Florida public college with a minimum 2.5 GPA. **Majors include: 1) Law Enforcement Operations, 2) Law Enforcement Intelligence, and 3) Crime Scene Investigation.**

FSU requires competency in oral communications for graduation. If students took a speech course in high school or were members of a debate team, they may exempt this requirement during the FSU admission process. If not, students **should take SPC 2608 at Chipola to satisfy this requirement. Grade of "C" or higher.**

FSU requires basic computer proficiency. **CGS 1060 or CGS 1100 will satisfy this requirement. Grade of "C" or higher required.** All first time in college (Fall 2014 and beyond) students are required to successfully complete two years of the same foreign language in high school or two semesters of the same foreign language at the college level before the associate degree is awarded. Home School students must demonstrate competency through competency testing.

FSU requires one Natural Science course with a Lab to be completed before graduation. This is not an admission requirement.
