Entrance Requirements

This is a limited access program. Eligibility for an individual will be based on the following: 1) completion of at least 52 semester hours; 2) cumulative grade point average on all college level work attempted of at least 2.90; and 3) satisfactory completion of required prerequisite coursework.

All first-time-in-college (Fall 2014 and beyond) students are required to successfully complete two years of the same foreign language in high school or two semesters of the same foreign language at the college level before the associate degree is awarded. Home School students must demonstrate competency through competency testing.

FSU requires competency in oral communications for graduation. If students took a speech course in high school or were members of a debate team, they may exempt this requirement during the FSU admissions process. If not, students may take **SPC 2608 at Chipola or GEB 3213, Business Communication, at FSU**. Must earn grade of "C" or higher.

FSU requires one Natural Science course with a Lab to be completed before graduation. This is not an admission requirement. Must earn a grade of "C" or higher.
