Entrance Requirements

This is a limited access program. All entering music majors are required to take a placement audition (heard by a faculty jury) in applied music. Students are expected to be prepared to play or sing representative works. A minimum GPA of 2.5 is required. Applicants must present passing scores on the general knowledge section of the FTCE for admission to the College of Education. A minimum music GPA of 3.0 is also required.

All first time in college (Fall 2014 and beyond) students are required to successfully complete two years of the same foreign language in high school or two semesters of the same foreign language at the college level before the associate degree is awarded. Home School students must demonstrate competency through competency testing. Students in this program must complete a modern or classical foreign language through 2200 level.

FSU requires basic computer proficiency. EME 2040 will satisfy this requirement.

FSU requires one Natural Science course with a Lab to be completed before graduation. This is not an admission requirement.
