**Entrance Requirements**

This is a limited access program.

A minimum GPA of 3.3 overall and in all critical tracking course work is required for consideration with no grade below "C". The nursing department application and all supporting materials must be RECEIVED by UF before March 1. **All coursework must be completed by the end of the spring semester prior to the anticipated fall registration (no more than two courses can be in progress during this term).**

UF will deny admission to any student who has not satisfied the state foreign language admissions requirement.

All students entering UF are required to possess a personal computer. Check this UF website (<http://www.circa.ufl.edu/computer.htm>) for a link to specific computer hardware and software configurations for this major.

Current CPR certification, personal health insurance, and Level II background check are required for admission.

All first time in college (Fall 2014 and beyond) students are required to successfully complete two years of the same foreign language in high school or two semesters of the same foreign language at the college level before the associate degree is awarded. Home School students must demonstrate competency through competency testing.
