Entrance Requirements

All first time in college (Fall 2014 and beyond) students are required to successfully complete two years of the same foreign language in high school or two semesters of the same foreign language at the college level before the associate degree is awarded. Home School students must demonstrate competency through competency testing. **This major is in the College of Arts and Sciences and requires completion of a foreign language through the 2220 level before graduation from FAMU.** If the additional foreign language is not taken before transfer, student will be required to take a placement test over the material covered in the first two years before being allowed to take additional foreign language. If the student does not pass, he/she may be denied admission into the program.
