Entrance Requirements

This is a limited access program.

A minimum GPA of 2.5 is required. Applicants must present passing scores on the general knowledge section of the FTCE. No grades below "C."

All first time in college (Fall 2014 and beyond) students are required to successfully complete two years of the same foreign language in high school or two semesters of the same foreign language at the college level before the associate degree is awarded. Home School students must demonstrate competency through competency testing.

FSU requires basic computer proficiency. EME 2040 will satisfy this requirement. Must earn a grade of "C" or higher.

Applicants must be fingerprinted and pass a security clearance before admission into the program.

FSU requires one Natural Science course with a Lab to be completed before graduation. This is not an admission requirement.
